Once again Diss failed to deliver with the players on show, Too many players spent time in the middle only to get out cheaply. In the 6th over Halvergate skipper Tim Crane (8-2-19-2) found the edge of Ben Spinks (1) bat to be caught behind, he followed that up with wicket of fellow opener Gareth Killian (5) playing on from an inside edge, this brought Charlie Pask in to join Kristian Williman and he announced his intentions with a 4 over mid- wicket.

together they put on 54 before Pask was caught for a good 36, Williman followed him in the next over for 17 after finding extra covers hands off the bowling of Millington, S.Howley (12-3-28-3) then picked up his second scalp bowling Kieran Pask with a pearler that swung in and then jagged back in even further to clip his off stump. Richard West (5) didn't get a chance to continue his recent form with the bat after finding the chest and then hands of mid-off.

Dan Williman (0) became Howley's 3rd victim lbw, Craig Barker was then Bowled for a well worked 22 before Jack Bell (0) and Andy Tebble (1) soon followed to end the innings on a disappointing 104.

With such a small total to defend early wickets would be essential, But S.Clarke and J.Howley rode their luck to find the boundary with a few edges that flew over the slips and gully, David Coleman on his debut bowled Howley with an in-swinging yorker for 13. L.Hannant was next to fall, after a few big hits he tried one too many and found the safe hands of Spinks off the bowling of West.

Along with P.Hill (4), Clarke steered Halvergate home for an unbeaten 57 to win by 8 wickets for a convincing win in the game that was sponsored by the Park Hotel .
