2012 Affiliation Fees now due

The Norfolk Cricket Board has now taken control of collection of all NCB Affiliation fees for 2012. These fees will no longer be collected through the leagues. Affiliation is now tiered and Fees for 2012 are as follows:

- PLATINUM: Focus Club, Chance to Shine and Clubmark: £120
- GOLD: Focus Club with Clubmark: £70
- SILVER: Clubmarked Club: £50
- BRONZE: All other clubs: £30
- DUAL: For clubs with a primary affiliation to another County: £25
